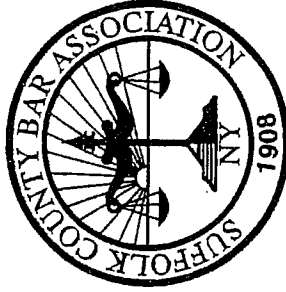

ACTIVE MEMBERSHIP

Any member of the Bar of the State of New York who resides in or maintains an office in Suffolk County, including any person who holds judicial office, may become an Active Member.

ASSOCIATE MEMBERSHIP

Any member of the Bar of the State of New York who neither resides in nor maintains an office in Suffolk County, and any member of the Bar of any other State, Territory, or the District of Columbia may become an Associate Member.

STUDENT MEMBERSHIP

Any individual regularly enrolled, and in good standing, in a law school accredited by the American Bar Association or, who is clerking pursuant to 22NYCRR§520.4, or is awaiting bar examination results or admission to the bar may become a Law Student Member.
